This letter is to inform you (the public) of the ongoing data collection that will take place in the upcoming weeks.

In 2015, the Regional Service Commission 8 formed a Regional Storm Water Management Committee to look at flooding in our Region and take a more Regional approach to mitigating the risks of flooding. An important part of this process is data collection and ensuring that we have current data in order to deal with the realities of climate change and its impacts on flooding.


Due to your close proximity to the river bank, you may see one of our staff members on the river bank in the upcoming weeks. The staff member will be equipped with gps and camera and will be walking along the river banks to capture data and take photos of the river.
