



## **Planning Review & Adjustment Committee (PRAC) Member Inventory**

Regional Service Commission 8 is currently accepting expressions of interest to serve on its Planning Review and Adjustment Committee. Interested individuals may be included in a member inventory to be evaluated and could be used to fill a vacancy if one arises.

The Planning Review and Adjustment Committee (PRAC) is appointed by the Regional Service Commission to carry out advisory and decision-making functions as specified under the Provincial Community Planning Act.

These responsibilities include, but are not limited to, decisions on variances to zoning provisions and the location of public streets or provision of other suitable access in a proposed plan of subdivision, and advice to either the Municipal Council or the Minister of Environment and Local Government as the case may be, on rezoning applications under their consideration.

As needed, the Planning Review and Adjustment Committee meets the third Tuesday of the month at 10:00 am to hear development applications for matters on land use planning.

Committee members must be eligible to vote under the Local Governance Act and be a resident in a community which gets its land use planning services from the RSC8.

In evaluating candidates for appointment to PRAC, consideration will be given to an applicant's knowledge of the land development trends, practices and issues; local government functions; and experience on volunteer-based committees. RSC8 shall seek a diversity of interests and backgrounds on the PRAC committee.

Please provide a resume and cover letter including details of education, volunteer, board/committee work experience relevant to the role, as well as why you are interested in being on the committee.
