

MOBILE ECO DEPOT

RSC8 has partnered with Eco360 to host several Mobile Eco Depots around the region.

Residents can drop off up to a half-ton and utility trailer load of accepted waste per event at no charge.

ACCEPTED ITEMS INCLUDE:

- Appliances
(1 of each type per vehicle)
- Electronic waste
- Furniture
- Small household machinery
(emptied of gas and oil)
- Construction, demolition & renovation material
- Household hazardous waste
Batteries, oil, paint, gas, etc
- Passenger car and truck tires
(maximum 20" diameter / 8 per vehicle)

PLEASE NOTE:

- We will accept one load (up to a half-ton truck and utility trailer) per resident per event
- Material must be boxed, bagged, or bundled for easy unloading (<30lbs)
- Maximum of 8 tires per resident
- Maximum of 40 fluorescent tubes per resident

WE DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Material containing asbestos
- Unsanitary / biomedical waste (pet waste, hygiene waste, etc)
- Tires greater than 20" diameter
- Commercial waste
- Regular curbside waste
- Gas or oil tanks
- Car parts
- Black bags

REGIONAL WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY

RSC8 operates the permanent Regional Waste Management Facility at **54 McLeod Drive in Sussex**. Residential and commercial waste is accepted at this facility **subject to tipping fees** based on the weight of the material.

The Regional Waste Management Facility does not accept tires or Household Hazardous Waste. These items require special handling and are only accepted at Mobile Eco Depot events.
