MOBILE ECO DEPOTS

We have partnered with Eco360 to host a number of Mobile Eco Depot events around the region. These Eco Depots combine our previous “Free Day” and “HHW Day” events into one convenient event.

Residents can drop off up to a half-ton and utility trailer load of accepted waste per event at no charge.

Accepted items include:

- Appliances
(1 of each type per vehicle)
- Electronic waste
- Furniture
- Small household machinery
(emptied of gas and oil)
- Construction, demolition & renovation material
- Household hazardous waste
(Batteries, oil, paint, gas, etc)
- Passenger car and truck tires
(maximum 20” diameter / 8 per vehicle)

BATTERIES & CFLS

Batteries and CFL bulbs are considered **Household Hazardous Waste** and are not part of the curbside collection program.

These items can be taken to any free Mobile Eco Depot event or any of our community collection points. Visit rsc8.ca or give us a call at **432-7530** to find the location closest to you.

FREE CARDBOARD DROPOFF

We accept flattened cardboard at the Regional Waste Management Facility (54 McLeod Dr, Sussex) at no charge during business hours.

If bringing cardboard, please report to the scale office before proceeding to the free cardboard bins.

Cardboard from our free bins as well as bundled material collected curbside are intercepted at our facility and recycled locally. This helps to fund other landfill diversion programs and to reduce tip fees at the Regional Waste Management Facility.
